Junior winners are Megan Blake, community service; Derek Lord, academic improvement; Nathan Ingram, attendance; and Timothy Heiss, academic excellence.

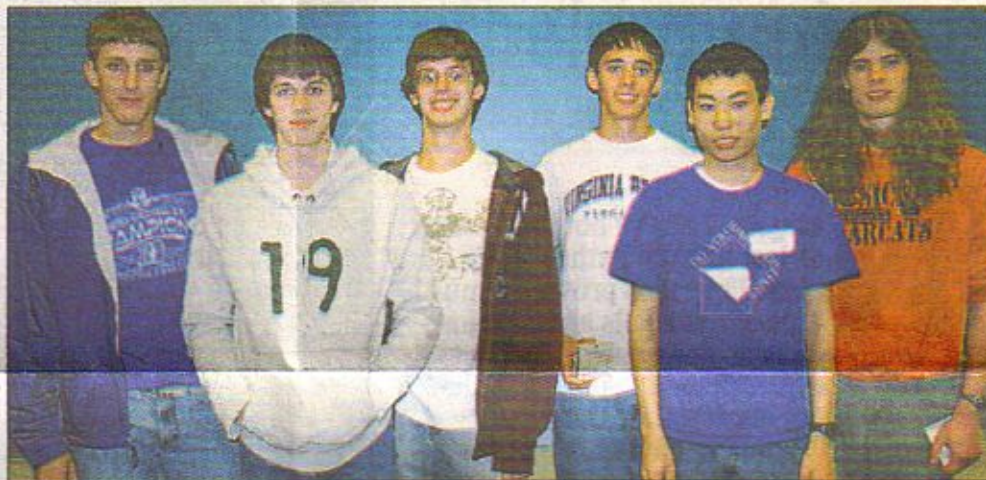
